## STUDENT WISH LIST PROJECT: QUICK FACT SHEET

- First nonprofit organization to create and utilize custom, online donation drives to increase wish list fulfillment for charities.
- Has generated >\$16,000 in 'wish list' item donations to date.
- Currently partnered with 13 charities:
  - **Backpacks for Life** (Verona, NJ): Nonprofit started and run by a veteran that distributes backpacks of essentials to homeless and at-risk veterans.
  - Children's Hospital of New Jersey (Newark, NJ): Hospital providing specialized medical services for children.
  - Covenant House (Newark, NJ): Crisis care and ongoing support for homeless youth under the age of 22.
  - **Deirdre's House** (Morristown, NJ): Morris County's center for child victims of abuse.
  - Family Promise of Morris County (Morris Plains, NJ): Nondenominational nonprofit working to address the crisis of homelessness in Morris County.
  - Good Grief (Morristown, Princeton, NJ): Support for grieving children and their families.
  - Goryeb Children's Hospital (Morristown, NJ): State-designated children's hospital.
  - Homeless Solutions (Morristown, NJ): Assistance for the homeless and working poor in Morris County.
  - Madison High School's Support Our Troops Campaign (Madison, NJ): Regular care packages for a local Marine's troop overseas.
  - Insulin for Life (Gainesville, FL): Collects insulin and other diabetes supplies for developing countries and disaster relief areas worldwide.
  - JBWS (Morristown, NJ): 24/7 support for victims of domestic violence and abuse (formerly Jersey Battered Women's Service).
  - NJAS (Morris Plains, NJ): Support and services for the local HIV+ and LGBTQ+ community (formerly New Jersey AIDS Services).
  - Saint Peter's Orphanage (Denville, NJ): Residential treatment facility for abused, abandoned, or neglected adolescent boys.
- 100% of all donations go directly to the receiving charities. SWLP is completely nonprofit and takes no fee or commission.
- Designed in part to provide volunteer opportunities that are currently lacking for school-age children. Students who conduct donation drives are eligible to apply to volunteer with our partnered charities or in-house with SWLP.
- Created by a family in Madison, NJ, based on their tradition of collecting donations off the local children's hospital's wish list in lieu of receiving birthday gifts for their kids.
